___ Attend the Wednesday, December 6, 2017 meeting

Purpose: An informational meeting to discuss the 2018-2019 KIS Honors Program.

Time: 5:30-6:30 P.M.

___ Register online for the testing day ideally at least a week before.

2 testing dates offered: January 20, 2018 and February 10, 2018

___ Take the KIS Honors Program Placement Testing (for students currently in the 6th grade).

When: Choose a date: **Saturday, January 20, 2018 or Saturday, February 10, 2018.**

Location: Kailua Intermediate School cafeteria

Time: 8:45 A.M. – 12:00 P.M.

Bring: pencils, a snack, a bottle of water, and a book

___ Turn in test voucher to your teacher and remind your teacher to send in your application (recommendation) form.

At the end of the test, your child must take a “test voucher” back to their teacher. This voucher lets the teachers know that your child took the honors test and is ready for the rest of their application to be processed.

___ Application form completed and submitted by the recommending teacher after students test and by Friday, February 23, 2018.

___ PARENTS are required to send in hard copies of student records to be received by Ms. Kutsunai by Saturday, February 10, 2018.

Records include:

- 1. copies of Report Cards with 5th grade year end grades and 6th grade first semester grades in all subjects,**
- 2. 5th grade or 6th grade SBA scores, Star Reading scores, and any other standard test scores available,**

*If you need copies, contact your child's school office.

*Please drop off hard copies of the above student records (report cards and test scores) to the Kailua Intermediate School office or to Ms. Kutsunai on the testing date (January or February at the KIS cafeteria).

Students' test scores and grades will be placed in a profile and these scores will determine eligibility for acceptance into the honors program. If a student is missing any of the required data, his/her application determination may be delayed.
