1. KIS Academic Plan. Dr. DeLong is almost done compiling the KIS Academic Plan. We reviewed a draft and discussed a few aspects especially ongoing professional development and AVID strategies that help our students in most every aspect of their studies.
2. Strive HI Results were further discussed from the final statistics that were officially posted. Shauna Hirota, KIS VP, discussed our standardized testing results. These numbers are based on a new test implemented last year. Our numbers, statistics, and overall percentages show improvement and that we are above the state and complex numbers in all areas.
