Aloha and Welcome to a new school year at Kailua Intermediate School!

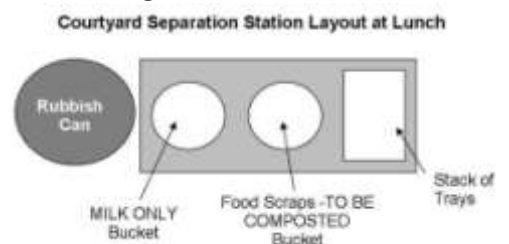
Thursday, August 16th 6 – 7:30 pm Parents: Please park on the grassy area near the office - enter via Kainalu Dr. near Kuukama Street.

KIS joined the Windward Zero Waste School Hui!

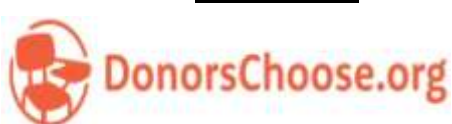
